	All sub sectors and working groups working on energy related matters in Somaliland shall coordinate with and report to the Energy Sector Coordination Forum. The Energy Sector Coordination Forum will ensure that all activities are aligned with the Somaliland National Development Plan.

Specific objectives	Specifically, the responsibilities and duties of the Energy Sector Coordination Forumare as follows:
	 To agree the priorities for the Somaliland energy sector over the next five years.
Sector priorities	• Guide the development and implementation of Somaliland's next five- year Energy Sector Strategy and ensure the Strategy is properly reflected and enabled through the Somaliland Development Plan.
Somaliland Development Plan	 Identify SMART (Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant and Timebound) annual activities to deliver on the strategic issues identified for the development of the energy sector.
Actionable annual activities	 Agree a division of labour between the Government, international development partners and implementing partners to deliver the Energy Sector Strategy to reduce the level of fragmentation of efforts.
Division of labour	 Map national and international funding flows into the energy sector, identify funding gaps, and agree actions to increase levels of funding for Energy Sector priorities.
Finance	 Coordinate national and international efforts and report annually on progress in the Sector, including challenges, gaps and next steps. Receive progress and updates from the sub-sectors/working groups.



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Coordination of implementation	 Promote and monitor the application of Energy Sector standards, policies, and guidelines across all stakeholders in the Sector.
Monitor implementation regulations	 Provide guidance on addressing challenges and gaps and promote the sharing of lessons from Sector activities.
Joint problem- solving	 Frequently plan and share energy sector related data collection and analysis to ensure that Sector activities are aligned to the guidelines of the Somaliland Development Plan and duplication of activities is avoided. Promote knowledge sharing and management of data collection, analysis and monitoring and evaluation findings.
Executive Committee	 Co-Chair: Ministry of Energy and Mineral Co-Chair: Ministry of National Planning Development Co-Chair: Development Partner State Minister of Energy and Minerals
Duties of Executive Committee	 Set the agenda for the Sector Coordination Working Group Co-Chair Sector Coordination Working Groups Report to the Inter-sectoral Working Groups, the High Level Aid Coordination Forums and other strategic platforms related to energy Guide the overall energy sector and identify ways to leverage additional resources (human and other) to further support the development of the Energy Sector.
